JUDGEMENT AND COMMON SENSE IN UNDERGROUND ENGINEERING

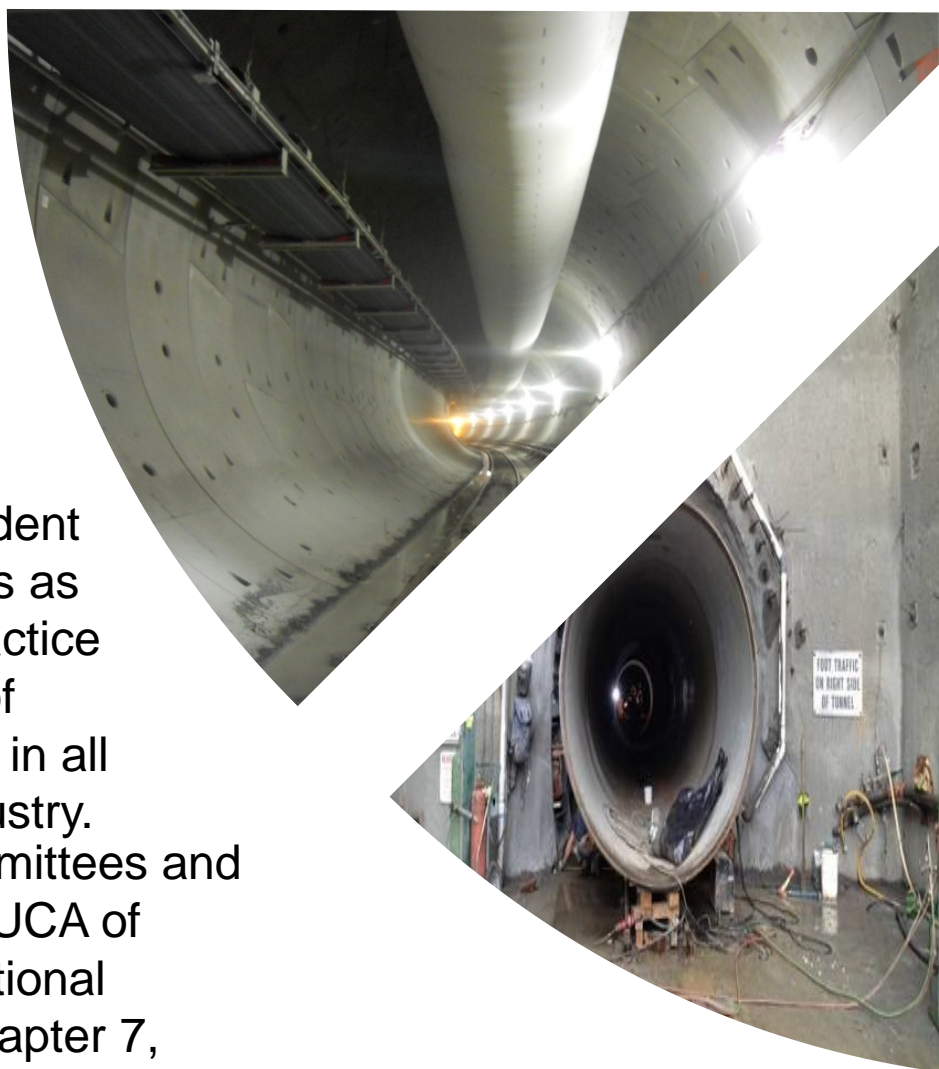
